Demonstrate golgi complex in human cells by IHC, FC or IF. AE-6 is an excellent marker for human cells in xenographic model research.

#### Format

Produced in tissue culture, contains no host Ig. Antibodies are affinity purified and presented in PBS with 0,02% sodium azide.

Stored at 4°C-8°C, shelf life is at least 24 months after purchase.

#### **Dilution advice**


- Flow cytometry (1-2 μg/million cells in 0,1 ml, fix cells in 4% PFA for 10 min, at 4°C, permeabilized with 0,2% saponin or digitonin for 15 min, at 4°C).
- > Immunoblotting (1-2  $\mu$ g/ml).
- Immunofluorescence (0,5-1,0 μg/ml).
- Immunohistology (1-2 μg/ml for 30 min at RT; staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires boiling tissue sections in 10mM citrate buffer, pH 6.0, for 10-20 min followed by cooling at RT for 20 minutes.

# **Positive control**

HepG2, A431 or HeLa cells, placenta, tonsil, testis and ovary.
