Source: Chicken

General description: Chicken polyclonal antibody to Miranda. This protein plays a role in neurogenesis in Drosophila embryos.

Alternative names: CG12249, Dmel\CG12249, mir, Mir, MIR, Mira, MIRA antibody.

Form: Polyclonal antibody supplied as a 100 μ l (3 mg/ml) aliquot in PBS, 20% glycerol and 0.05% sodium azide. This antibody is epitope-affinity purified from yolk egg.

Immunogen: Recombinant peptide derived from within residues 220 aa to the N-terminus of Drosophila melanogaster Miranda produced in E. coli.

Specificity: Detects endogenous levels of Miranda protein by immunofluorescence.

Reactivity: Reacts with Fruit fly proteins



Usage:


WB: 1:500-1:2,000 IF: 1:50-1:500

Storage: For continuous use, store at 2-8 deg;C for one-two days. For extended storage, store in -20 deg;C freezer. Working dilution samples should be discarded if not used within 12 hours.

Special instructions: The antibody solution should be gently mixed before use...
